Aviation Weather 101

FAR Weather Minimums

- 91.155 Basic VFR weather minimums (abridged)
 - Class B
 - Visibility => 3SM
 - Distance from clouds => Clear of clouds
 - Class C, D, E below 10,000 feet MSL:
 - Visibility => 3SM
 - Distance from clouds => 500' below, 1,000' above, 2,000' horizontal
 - Class G =< 1,200' AGL
 - Day: Visibility => 1SM, Clear of clouds
 - Night: Visibility =>3SM, 500' below, 1,000' above, 2,000' horizontal



Weather Basics

 The atmosphere is thicker at the equator and thinner at the poles and would flow in a circular pattern between the equator and poles if...




Figure 11-3. Circulation pattern in a static environment.

- Spinning Storms





Figure 11-5. Three-cell circulation pattern due to the rotation of the Earth.



Weather Simplified


Weather = moisture and wind

Aviation Weather 101

Personal Minimums

- Ceiling a 1,000' AGL is legal but watch out for towers
- Visibility 3SM is not good, 6SM is still not great, 10SM good
- Winds depends on the plane and your crosswind comfort
- Routes GPS direct, Airways, unpopulated areas, IFR (I Follow Roads)
- Distance Aircraft range, how long can you hold it?
- Altitude air is thinner higher up; less oxygen
