Chapter 93 Scholarships

EAA Corben Chapter 93 is a non-profit aviation organization with a goal of encouraging participation in aviation through ongoing outreach, educational programs, and activities. To achieve this goal, Chapter 93 offers several scholarship opportunities to qualified applicants to support their continued aviation-related educational activities.

Not all scholarships are available every year.

All Chapter 93 members in good standing for at least six months are eligible to apply for scholarship opportunities.

To apply for a Chapter 93 scholarship, please read and complete this form in its entirety and submit the completed application with all supporting documentation and send via email to scholarships@eaa93.org. An applicant can also hand-deliver their application materials in person at any chapter event.

All scholarships require additional supporting documentation which *must be included at the time of application*. Refer to the Scholarship Requirements section of each scholarship for pertinent details.

Missing or inaccurate information may delay consideration or disqualify an applicant.

Scholarships

Flight Training Scholarships

___ EAA Ray Aviation Scholarship

This scholarship is a joint effort between EAA and Chapter 93 and is geared towards high school students. The Ray Aviation Scholarship will assist with the cost of obtaining a private pilot certificate, up to \$12,000.

Applicant Documentation Requirements

To apply for this scholarship, an applicant must include:

- An essay explaining how this scholarship will help you, describing your aviation goals, detailing your timeline for achievement of your pilot certificate, and outlining how you will fulfill the two-hour per month Chapter volunteer requirement of the scholarship.
- EAA Chapter 93 Parental Letter of Consent for Scholarship Application (available from Chapter 93 website)
- A letter of recommendation from your current flight instructor if you have already begun flight training.
- A personal letter of recommendation from an individual outside your immediate family.
- A sponsor letter from an active member of EAA Chapter 93, who has been a member for at least one year, describing your engagement in Chapter activities and why they believe you will be a good recipient of the scholarship.
- A copy of at least a third-class medical certificate for powered flight scholarships. (See notes below)
- A copy of the student pilot certificate which can be obtained from any local flight school.

In addition to the Chapter-required documentation requirements listed above, the EAA Ray Aviation Scholarship may request additional documentation upon receipt of a scholarship award.

A medical certificate is *required* to earn a pilot certificate and participate in the program. To learn more about medical certification requirements please consult with an Aviation Medical Examiner (AME).

EAA Chapter 93 Flight Training Scholarship

Intended for post-solo student pilots of any age, this scholarship will pay up to \$1,500 directly to a flight school or FBO towards instructor time or airplane rental necessary to obtain a private pilot certificate.

Applicant Documentation Requirements

To apply for this scholarship, an applicant must include:

- An essay explaining how this scholarship will help you, describing your aviation goals, and detailing your timeline for achievement of your pilot certificate.
- A letter of recommendation from your current flight instructor.
- A personal letter of recommendation from an individual outside your immediate family.
- A sponsor letter from an active member of EAA Chapter 93, who has been a member for at least one year, describing your engagement in Chapter activities and why they believe you will be a good recipient of the scholarship.

Youth Scholarships

EAA Chapter 93 Air Academy Campership

Every year, EAA in Oshkosh puts on several four-day-long summer camps. Known as the EAA Air Academy, the event is held at the Air Academy Lodge in Oshkosh, and participants are engrossed in aviation and STEM education. This scholarship is intended for kids ages 12 - 17 and it will pay a portion of the registration fee. Travel expenses to and from the event are outside the scope of this scholarship and the responsibility of the applicant's family. Previous participation in the EAA Young Eagles program is encouraged but not required.

Additional Supporting Documentation Required

- A short essay explaining why you would like to attend the Air Academy.
- A letter of reference from a parent, guardian, or school teacher.
- A sponsor letter from an active member of EAA Chapter 93, who has been a member for at least one year, describing your engagement in Chapter activities and why they believe you will be a good recipient of the scholarship.

Technical Scholarships

___ Bill Rewey Memorial Builders Scholarship

Named after the late Bill Rewey, a long-time Chapter 93 member and prolific aircraft mechanic and builder, this scholarship will pay up to \$1,500 for individual or group training to enhance skills related to aircraft building or maintenance. It may also be used to purchase specialty tools that will be retained by the Chapter and loaned out to other members to assist with their projects.

Additional Supporting Documentation Required

- A document describing your project and explaining how this scholarship will help you complete it.
